BASIC INCOME

What is it?

It is an **economic support** measure intended to combat poverty with the aim of **reintegration into the world of work and social inclusion.**



It is called **Pensione di Cittadinanza (Basic Pension)** if the family unit is made up of people aged 67 years or over and/or people with disabilities.

Who is it for?

Persons whose ISEE is less than € 9,360.
Assessments include income, property
and assets owned by the family unit.

Requirements

You can apply if

- 1**
 - you are an Italian or EU citizen
 - you are a family member of EU citizens
 - you have a long-term residence permit (settled status)
 - you have international protection

- 2** **you have resided in Italy for 10 years**, of which at least the last two are continuous

effective residence

You have not been registered in the civil registry for 10 years?

You are entitled to RdC (Basic Income)

It is sufficient to have lived legally in Italy for at least 10 years. You must prove this with residence permits, medical and employment documents and rental contracts. Send these documents to the Local Council (Comune) requesting notification of the correct period of residence to INPS.

You have not resided in Italy for at least 10 years?

According to ASGI, this requirement is discriminatory

We are working to have it changed. If you want to apply without having 10 years of residence, you must send a certified email (PEC) to the INPS office for your city/province specifying the effective years of residence.

Did you apply and your RdC was denied or revoked because of the 10-year residency requirement?

Contact a Citizens Advice Bureau (patronato), trade union or association that assists migrants to consider the possibility of taking legal action.
